## Entries

Competitors must enter through the Secretary of their Home Club who is to sign the declaration on the entry form.

Entries shall be made only on the special Entry Form (photocopies are acceptable).

Entries will only be accepted from players whose handicaps do not exceed 12 strokes. If oversubscribed, a ballot of handicaps will take place.

The entrance fee of £20, together with the fully completed Entry Form must be received by the Tournament Organiser, by no later than Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2019. (All cheques to be made payable to Morlais Castle Golf Club).

Entrance Fees will not be refunded unless intimation of scratching is received before the closing date for entries. Entrants who may be balloted out and subsequently don't compete will be refunded.

## Rules & Conditions

Starting times will be forwarded to all competitors for order of play.

The Tournament shall be decided by strokes over 2 rounds of golf of 18 holes each. The Tournament will be played in accordance with the rules of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, subject to any local rules applying at the time.

A competitor must be of amateur status as defined by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews.

In the event of a tie, the winner shall be decided by the lowest score for the last 18 holes (or 9, or 6, or 3, or 1). If a tie still arises, the scores for the 1<sup>st</sup> round shall be treated in the same way until a decision is reached.

Players shall start at the time laid down by the Tournament Organising Committee. Competitors who arrive late will be penalised.

All disputes must be referred to the Tournament Organising Committee whose decision will be final.
